

On Saturday, June 29, the Town of Occoquan held a ceremony formally assigning the 100 block of Poplar Alley the honorary designation, "Ogle Harris Way" in honor of the contributions of the late Ogle Harris and his family to the town of Occoquan.

THE HARRIS STORY

In the early years of the 20th century, Ogle Harris began a business out of his four-room home at 204 Washington Street, among other activities selling ice cream from the African-American Oddfellows Hall that used to sit on Washington Street and Poplar Alley near what was then Ebenezer Baptist Church. Eventually moving his family into a larger home on the corner of Washington and Commerce streets, he turned his former home into full-fledged grocery, and by the end of the century's second decade it had become one of Occoquan's thriving businesses, selling meat, fresh produce, fishing tackle, sodas, candy, and sundry other goods. Unlike many other businesses in Occoquan at the time, Ogle Harris accepted purchases on credit, keeping the transactions in a spiral-bound notebook.

Through his marriages to Coral L. Peyton and Lottie Bowles, Mr. Harris helped raise seven children in Occoquan. His store became an Occoquan institution and a cornerstone of the town's commercial and African-American communities, remaining so after his passing in 1949 after which it was operated under the auspices of his son Arthur and his daughter-in-law Doris, until it formally closed in 1974.

In addition to historic photographs of Ogle Harris and members of his family that are on display at the Occoquan Historical Society's Mill House Museum (413 Mill Street, Occoquan, VA), the historical society also has recordings of an oral history from one of Ogle Harris's daughters, the late Saluka Toliver (who along with another daughter, Artie Harris, lived to more than 100 years old). Among her many recollections, Ms. Toliver remembers the hand-cranked machine with which her father made ice cream, the crackling wood stove that warmed the store and around which customers would congregate on cold winter afternoons, and the bench placed near the front door after her father's death, providing a place to rest and watch the activity on Washington Street.

For much of the 20th century, Ogle Harris's store, along with Ebenezer Baptist Church and the no longer extant Oddfellows Hall, were the center of what was once a small but thriving African-American community located on Occoquan's Washington Street.

THE MEMORY LIVES ON

The ceremony on June 29, 2024, which was attended by several local elected officials and Harris family relatives from as far away as Kentucky, included remarks by Occoquan Mayor Earnie Porta, a musical selection by family member Tamika Joy, recollections by members of the extended family, and the presentation of resolutions from the Town of Occoquan and U.S. Representative Abigail Spanberger, honoring Ogle Harris and his descendants.

Visit the Occoquan Historical Society's Mill House Museum at 413 Mill Street to see some of the historic photographs of Ogle Harris, his family, and what was once the heart of Occoquan's African-American community.

"Ogle Harris was an upstanding neighbor, business owner, and Virginian whose dedication to bettering his community has been fondly remembered by Occoquan residents even 75 years after his passing,"



OUR BUSINESSES

Occoquan knows small businesses. There are 140+ small and family owned businesses here in town in the shape of retail shops, restaurants, galleries, salons, services, and more. Visit pages 14-15 to see the Town of Occoquan Map and Directory or browse our online directory at visitoccoquanva.com.

PARKING

Free public street and lot parking is available throughout town. The Timed Parking District in the historic/business edge of town has free 4 and 8 hour timed parking, with occasional 20-minute pick up spots throughout town.

RESTROOMS

Accessible public restrooms are available at River Mill Park (458 Mill Street) and Mill Street Draft Garden (200 Mill Street).

PET FRIENDLY

Many shops and restaurants are pet friendly. Be sure to call ahead to confirm, if you plan to have your furry friend accompany you. Our historical district and parks have waste receptacles and bags for your convenience.

KAYAK/SUP RAMP

The Town of Occoquan, Virginia kayak and SUP ramp is free and open to the public. It can be accessed through the 8-hour parking lot at 111 Mill St. The ramp has direct access into the Occoquan River (connecting to the Potomac River) and is accessible for people with mobility disabilities.

MAMIE DAVIS PARK

Occoquan's Mamie Davis Park (205 Mill Street) was named in honor of the late, long-time resident and town official, Ms. Mamie Davis. Located at the intersection of Washington Street and Mill Street, this small grassed and shaded public area features a gazebo, and connects to the town's public boardwalk and pier. It is often used as a setting for weddings, receptions, and other events.

BIRD WATCHING

Occoquan is a great place to watch and photograph numerous species of waterfowl and raptors including ospreys, blue heron, eagles, mallards, Canadian geese, kingfishers, and more. The entire Town of Occoquan is designated as a bird sanctuary.

MILL HOUSE MUSEUM

The Mill House Museum contains an eclectic collection of documents, photographs, and other artifacts related to Occoquan's history and that of the surrounding region. Over 400 items are catalogued and many of these are on permanent display. One strength is the Historical Society's collection of Occoquan-related photographs. While a number of these are on display in the Museum, many more have yet to be catalogued and made available to the general public. 413 Mill Street. Open daily (except Wednesdays) from 11am-4pm.

RIVER MILL PARK

The Town of Occoquan, in partnership with Prince William County and Fairfax Water, developed River Mill Park, a one-acre park along the Occoquan River with a public restroom, event pavilion, open space, and paved walking trail. River Mill Park was opened to the public in July of 2016 and is used by the Town to host concerts and other family-friendly events, as well as by the community for various public and private events.


FOOTBRIDGE

The Nathaniel Ellicott Bridge is located on the site of a bridge originally constructed in the late 1700s, which put Occoquan on the main north-south route of the East Coast until the coming of Route 1. An iron Pratt truss bridge was erected on the site in 1878 and carried Route 123 across the river and through the Town of Occoquan. In 1972 Hurricane Agness washed away the bridge and a footbridge replaced it.

TOWN DOCK

The Town of Occoquan Boardwalk and Public Dock are accessible via Mamie Davis Park (205 Mill St). Public picnic tables and benches are available for public use. Contact Town Hall at (703) 491-1918 for docking fee and information. No reservation are needed and slips are first come, first serve.






